CAST OF CHARACTERS

BILLY, male, any race, any age.

HOLLY, female, any race, any age.

JON, male, Holly's husband, roughly same age as HOLLY.

TIME AND PLACE

Holly and Jon's home and Billy's office.

Present day.

Scene opens to a black stage. A spotlight comes up, stage right, on BILLY, who is sitting at his desk, wearing a headset.

Then, a second spotlight comes up on HOLLY, who is sitting stage left, talking on her cell phone.

BILLY

1 800 DIVORCE. You marry them, we bury them. This is Billy. With whom am I speaking?

HOLLY

Oh hi, Billy. This is Holly.

BILLY

Married name?

HOLLY

Wood.

BILLY

No wonder you want out. You took your husband's name?

HOLLY

I was in love.

BILLY

If you say so Hollywood.

HOLLY

Can you hook me up?

BILLY

With who?

HOLLY

With a hot divorce attorney, who else?

BILLY

Oh honey, you want 1 800 lower-the-bar, that new service for desperate, horny lawyers, I'll give you their number. Actually, I just did.

No, you idiot. It's gotten so bad with my husband, that we can barely co-exist. I need an attorney as a buffer, to get between us.

BILLY

A ménage à trois? Honey, we don't really offer that either, at least not yet.

HOLLY

I don't want a three-way, I want a big, fat settlement.

BILLY

Well why didn't you say so? What's your status?

HOLLY

Separated.

BILLY

But you want out?

HOLLY

YES.

BILLY

And your spouse agrees?

HOLLY

Sort of. He wants to stay married but

BILLY

You told him it's over?

HOLLY

Yes.

BILLY

And you're rich?

HOLLY

Very.

BILLY

And he, what, slept with your sister?

How did you know?

BILLY

Honey, I been doing this a long time.

HOLLY

Then you can help me?

BILLY

Sure, but by law, I'm required to inform you that divorce is a long, expensive, even life-threatening process.

HOLLY

I wasn't born yesterday.

BILLY

I'm still obligated by the state of California to ask, have you attempted reconciliation?

HOLLY

He slept with my sister!

BILLY

So?

HOT.T.V

You don't think that's grounds?

BILLY

Not really. Was it more than once?

HOLLY

Twice, that I know of.

BILLY

Oh please, tell him to buy you a new Tesla and call it a day.

HOLLY

No. I'm too hurt.

BILLY

You've never stepped outside your marriage?

HOLLY

I don't see how that's any of your business.

BILLY

Honey, it's all my business. Have you?

HOLLY

It depends on how you define ... stepping outside the marriage.

BILLY

Have you engaged in extramarital sex?

HOLLY

What is sex after all?

BILLY

I get it, "I did not have sex with that woman, Monica Lewinsky." Is that where this is going?

HOLLY

Something like that.

BILLY

Did Hillary buy it?

HOLLY

What is your point?

BILLY

My point, if you've been the slightest unfaithful, this whole thing could blow up in your face.

HOLLY

BILLY

Who was it?

HOLLY

I'm not comfortable revealing that, it's ... sensitive.

BILLY

Hollywood?

HOLLY

Oh all right, my neighbor's ...

BILLY

HOLLY

You didn't let me finish, it's my neighbor's son ... and ...

BILLY

And what?

HOLLY

And, maybe one of his friends.

BILLY

Just one?

HOLLY

Okay, two. All right, three.

BILLY

HOLLY

Okay, five.

BILLY

College kids?

HOLLY

BILLY

HOLLY

BILLY
