CAT 2

I'm the one that's changing. Not you.

CHRIS

Will you still be Cat though? Will you still be my Cat?

CAT 2

I don't know.

CHRIS

Will I recognize you?

CAT 2

Of course you will.

CHRIS

How will I recognize you?

CAT 2

I'll still be me. To you, I'll still be me.

CHRIS Will you have the same face? CAT 2 Chris, please. CHRIS Sorry. I'm sorry. It's just a lot to take in. THREE CAT 2 has vanished. CAT 1 in her place. CHRIS Hungry? CAT 1 No. CHRIS Thirsty? CAT 1 No. CHRIS Need anything? CAT 1 You to shut up. CHRIS Ok. Did you hear about -CAT 1 Seriously? CHRIS What? CAT 1 Small talk? CHRIS I just -CAT 1 Ask me how the fucking weather is.

CHRIS Do you actually -CAT 1 No I don't fucking -CHRIS Alright. Alright. So you won't miss me at all? CAT 1 I won't remember you. That's the point. CHRIS Right. Like, if you saw me on the street, you wouldn't recognize me? Not even a little? CAT 1 Do you think if you just keep talking then I won't go? Think you can distract me for long enough to win me over? CAT 2 Don't I? CHRIS Not really. CAT 2 I'm sorry. CHRIS Are you her? CAT 2 Who? CHRIS Cat. My Cat. CAT 2 You've lost your cat? CHRIS No - Well, yes. CAT 2 You've lost your little kitty-cat? CHRIS Yes. I don't know where she is. CAT 2 Would you like me to help you find her? FIVE CHRIS and CAT 1. CAT 1 Would you fuck a mermaid? CHRIS Yes. CAT 1 That was fast! No hesitation or ... CHRIS I've thought about this before and my answer is yes. CAT 1 Ok, ok, so you'd stick your dick in a fish? CHRIS Well... CAT 1 That's essentially what you're saying. CHRIS Um... CAT 2 Wow. CHRIS No. Wait. CAT 2 You want me all to yourself. CHRIS Hang on. Run that by me again. CAT 2 You'd be dead. I'd still be alive. CHRIS Then yes. CAT 2 Yes what? CHRIS I'd want you to still be alive. I want you to live. CAT 2 Even though you wouldn't be around? CHRIS Yeah. Of course. I want you to have life. Pause. Do you... CAT 2 Hmm? CHRIS Do you... want me... to live? CAT 2 Of course I do. CHRIS Good. Good. CAT 2 Why would you even ask that?

CHRIS You weren't exactly forthcoming with the whole ... CAT 2 The whole? CHRIS The whole shebang. CAT 2 Shebang? CHRIS Wanting me to be alive. CAT 2 I wasn't wishing you dead. CHRIS You weren't exactly rushing to my aid! CAT 2 You weren't dying! CHRIS If I was, would you try to save my life? CAT 2 Of course I would. CHRIS How would you save me? CHRIS

CAT 2

Hey remember that time we had no AC all summer and lost twenty pounds?

CHRIS

CAT 1

Hey remember that time we went ice skating in Central Park on Christmas Eve and saw that woman get her finger sliced off by a skate?

CHRIS

No.

CAT 2

Hey remember that time?

CHRIS

No.

CAT 1

Hey remember that time?

CHRIS

No.

CAT 2

Hey remember that time?

CHRIS

No.

CAT 1

Hey remember that time we got really drunk and I proposed to you and we got engaged and we were still so drunk in the morning we totally forgot it had happened until we realized you had the ring pull from a PBR can on your finger well really it was in your finger it was

Hey remember that time your mom died and I held you so close and so tight that you couldn't breathe and when I let go you breathed and let out a wail like an animal that's just lost a part of itself and you cried yourself to sleep while I stroked your head and told you everything was going to be alright?

CAT 2

Hey remember that time you loved me and I loved you and we were in love?

CAT 1

Hey remember that time?

CAT 2

Hey remember that time?

A long pause.

CHRIS

I don't remember.

NINE

CAT 1 goes in the fridge and comes out as **CAT 2**. **CAT 2** goes in and comes out as **CAT 1**. Repeat. Repeat.

TEN

CHRIS opens the fridge door slowly. It's empty. He closes it, then opens it quickly. It's still empty.

CHRIS

Hello? Is anyone there? Cat? Cat?

ELEVEN

CHRIS and **CAT 2**. He addresses everything he says to her. She doesn't react. He snaps sharply between moods.

CHRIS

Have you seen my Cat? I can't find my Cat. Have you seen her? Will you help me find my Cat?

Hey. Hey you. Hey girl. Hey sweetie. How you doing? Huh? How you doing tonight? Come on, give me a smile. Give me a little smile huh? Hey don't ignore me! I'm just trying to nice! I just want to be your friend!

I'd like to place an ad. Yeah like a lost love kinda thing? Like an I Saw You kinda thing. Yeah like I saw you on the train I liked your hat and you were reading Camus kinda thing.

Hello? Police? Is this the police? I need to talk to the police. Missing persons. She's gone. She's missing. I can't find my Cat. I've lost my Cat. Will anyone help me find my Cat?

TWELVE

CHRIS and CAT 1 slow dance to Sharon Van Etten's 'Love More'. CAT 1 drifts away and CAT 2 replaces her. Then CHRIS drifts away. CAT 1 and CAT 2 dance with each other. Then they all separate, dancing in their own spaces. Then CAT 1 and CAT 2 disappear, leaving CHRIS standing alone. CHRIS looks at the fridge. He goes to it. He goes through.

THIRTEEN

CAT 1 and CHRIS.

CAT 1

If you could change your life forever in one moment, would you?

CHRIS

What do you mean?

CAT 1

Like, you'd do something and afterwards, things would be different.

CHRIS

That's pretty vague. Give me an example.

CAT 1

If you could, I don't know, disappear.

CHRIS

Like, turn invisible?

CAT 1

No!

CHRIS

What then?

CAT 1

Vanish. Hit the road. Drop everything and walk away.

CHRIS

And then what would happen?

CAT 1

I don't know! Do you need me to spell everything out for you? Use your imagination Chris. Make a choice. And be prepared for the eventuality that you can't go back on it. You won't know if it's going to succeed. You won't know if things will be better after you make this

choice until you've made it. And even then you might not know for sure. It's a gamble.

CHRIS

What if I don't make a choice? Isn't that a choice in itself?

CAT 1

So you're saying that the absence of a choice is a choice?

CHRIS

CHRIS

So why do I need to make a big choice? Why do I need to change my life?

CAT 1

This is enough for you?

CHRIS

I have you. You're all I need.

CAT 1

I'm not enough.

CHRIS

That's not for you to decide. To me you are enough. More than enough.

CAT 1

Then I decide that I don't want that responsibility. I don't want you to measure my worth.

CHRIS

I'm not Cat. I'm not saying it's about worth or value. Do I value you? Yes.

That doesn't make you some sort of commodity. You're not a thing to be bought.

CAT 1

Oh thanks for mansplaining -

CHRIS

I'm not trying to -

CAT 1 Pretty much sounds like -CHRIS Cat please! CAT 1 What? CHRIS I can't fucking win here. I'm trying to be nice. CAT 1 Who wants nice? CHRIS Nice people do. CAT 1 So I'm not? CHRIS Maybe not. CAT 1 Wow. CHRIS Look, of course you're nice. There's nothing wrong with nice. When did being nice become such a crime? CAT 1 When it got boring. CHRIS And when was that? CAT 1 When naughty got invented and people were like 'yes please, I'll have a bit of that'. CHRIS I don't even know what you're saying now. CAT 1 It's not difficult. CHRIS Wow, thanks. CAT 1 It's about putting my life in motion. CHRIS It's not moving now? CAT 1 No. CHRIS So running away from me is the answer? CAT 1 Chris. My life is static. He drags himself out, reaches back his hand and pulls out CAT 2, also in white tank and underwear. They fall to the ground, drag themselves up to standing and look out, wide-eyed. The buzz gets louder than the music, the lights get brighter, until CAT 2 runs to the fridge door and slams it shut.
