CHAUNCEY'S APARTMENT

AIDEN It's mostly junk mail — And you smell like (*coughs*) CHAUNCEY What does this one say? AIDEN Let me read it — CHAUNCEY Is it from my girlfriend? AIDEN She broke up with you — CHAUNCEY She did? AIDEN Before hibernation? CHAUNCEY Oh, crumbs! Really? AIDEN She was worried you'd give her leptospirosis! CHAUNCEY

Nobody's perfect!

AIDEN

And she was bored!

CHAUNCEY

I'm not boring!

AIDEN

Usually when someone says, "Let's grab a bite" they mean figuratively, from a restaurant, instead of literally from a trash can.

CHAUNCEY

That is ridiculous! Now read my mail!

AIDEN

This is from Central Services Municipal Court —

CHAUNCEY

Ooh! I'm important!

AIDEN Each year the Municipal Court surveys a randomly selected —

CHAUNCEY

Halt! There is no "Dear" at the beginning?

AIDEN

Straight to the facts, yeah —

CHAUNCEY

Civility!

AIDEN

"A randomly selected group of citizens" —

CHAUNCEY

Of my fine adopted home!

AIDEN

How *did* you get here from England?

CHAUNCEY

I came with the bananas!

AIDEN

Shall I continue?

CHAUNCEY

I'm hungry —

AIDEN

You want some pretzels?

CHAUNCEY

Yes! I love pretzels.

AIDEN

Here's your pretzels and your water —

CHAUNCEY washes his pretzels in the water as he eats them.

(*Eating.*) Read my letter!

AIDEN

AIDEN

CHAUNCEY

AIDEN

CHAUNCEY

AIDEN

That's a really low standard.

CHAUNCEY

Fine! I'll do the bloody survey! And my valuable input will guide the City in making more service improvements that reflect the needs of our community.

AIDEN

Our community?

CHAUNCEY

Bipeds!

AIDEN

Question one — Finding the courthouse was easy. Strongly agree? Agree? Neither agree nor disagree? Disagree or Strongly disagree?

CHAUNCEY

Not applicable.

Why?

CHAUNCEY

AIDEN

Not applicable!

AIDEN

Question two — The forms I needed were clear and easy to understand —

Do you like my habitat?

AIDEN

Can we stay on track please?

CHAUNCEY

CHAUNCEY

I've focused so much on keeping dominant males out of here, I forgot throw pillows ----

AIDEN

Question three —

CHAUNCEY

Women love throw pillows! And air freshener —

AIDEN "I was able to get my court business done in a reasonable" —

CHAUNCEY

Cheryl said my musk is overpowering!

AIDEN

Well —

CHAUNCEY

•••

AIDEN Maybe you could get this place cleaned up?

CHAUNCEY

Not applicable, Aiden!

AIDEN Question 13 — I was treated the same as everyone else —

CHAUNCEY

No one respects my loose social groups!

AIDEN

Strongly agree? Agree? Neither —

CHAUNCEY I'm on a constant search for females who are fertile!

AIDEN

Dude —

CHAUNCEY

When I encounter a female to mate with, it will usually be at a central meeting place in my home range.

AIDEN

And how's that working out for you?

CHAUNCEY

They love my odor marks!

AIDEN

Cheryl called you "an infestation".

CHAUNCEY That's just her fancy way of saying I'm *adaptable*.

AIDEN

You're disgusting —

CHAUNCEY

I'm highly intelligent — And curious!

AIDEN

You're vermin.

CHAUNCEY I have five long toes and fingers, resembling human hands. (*Weeps*.)

AIDEN

You tip trash cans! You raid bird feeders — You pilfer gardens! You — Pilferer!

CHAUNCEY

That's a lie!

AIDEN Face it, Chauncey — You may possess amazing dexterity, but —

CHAUNCEY

AIDEN

AIDEN

Chauncey — All you damage is relationships.

CHAUNCEY

CHAUNCEY

AIDEN

CHAUNCEY

AIDEN
