# Cast of Characters

**ELAINE SILVER** Age 45-70: A wealthy Upper-Eastside New Yorker who has been married to Buddy for a very long time.

BUDDY SILVER Age 45-70: A wealthy Upper-Eastside New Yorker who has been married to Elaine for a very long time.

## WHEN THE WORLD FALLS IN LOVE

**SETTING:** The Upper-Eastside (NYC) bedroom of BUDDY and ELAINE.

AT RISE: Buddy sits in a wing chair reading a novel, oblivious to ELAINE'S singing which we hear from off-stage.

TIME: Months away from Christmas.

(ELAINE enters singing "The Christmas Waltz". She is wearing a large black tunic, black tights, ballet flats and enormous costume jewelry. (Very 1970's Liza Minnelli). SHE tries to get BUDDY to look up from his book and notice her by strutting and posing as if she were on a runway).

## **ELAINE**

(Singing "The Christmas Waltz")

IT'S THAT TIME OF YEAR
WHEN THE WORLD FALLS IN LOVE,
WHEN EACH SONG YOU HEAR
SEEMS TO SAY...

(SHE poses in front of BUDDY. HE doesn't notice)

MERRY CHRISTMAS...

(BUDDY looks up at her and stares. SHE raises her arms in sort of a MITZI GAYNOR pose. Finally, after a beat, he speaks)

**BUDDY** 

What?

**ELAINE** 

What?!?

BUDDY

What???

ELAINE

That's it? That's all you've got to say? WHAT!?!?

BUDDY

Okay...why?

**ELAINE** 

Why what?

BUDDY

Why are you singing that insipid Christmas song?

**ELAINE** 

What's wrong with it?

**BUDDY** 

It's depressing.

**ELAINE** 

I love that song...

BUDDY

Well, you shouldn't be singing it anyway...

**ELAINE** 

Okay Mr. Scrooge, can you me one good reason why I shouldn't sing...?

BUDDY

I'll give you three reasons!

**ELAINE** 

I withdraw the question!

BUDDY

Firstly, it's not Christmastime. We are months away from Christmas!

**ELAINE** 

That's not a reason...

BUDDY

Secondly... we're Jewish.

**ELAINE** 

So what!?!

BUDDY

It's a Christmas song.

It's non-religious...

BUDDY

It's a Christmas song. Christmas is a Christian holiday...

**ELAINE** 

No...it's secular...like "Baby It's Cold Outside". Jews have been singing these songs for decades.

BUDDY

"Baby It's Cold Outside" is not a Christmas song...

**ELAINE** 

It's sung in the winter!

**BUDDY** 

So???

ELAINE

So what? Are you trying to start a fight?

**BUDDY** 

And thirdly...

**ELAINE** 

And thirdly because I can't sing. I know...you've told me.

**BUDDY** 

That is not what I was going...

**ELAINE** 

You know what...

(SHE moves to the mirror to check her hair)

Just leave me alone...

BUDDY

Don't you want to know what my third point was going to be...

**ELAINE** 

No.

**BUDDY** 

The third reason you shouldn't be singing that song...

No! I do not want to know...

BUDDY

Firstly, was because it's not Christmastime. Secondly, because we are Jewish. And thirdly…aren't you even a little bit curious?

ELAINE

Okay! Okay! What is the nasty-assed third reason?

BUDDY

Thirdly, you shouldn't be singing that song because it is not true.

**ELAINE** 

What is not true?

BUDDY

Christmas is **not** the time of year when "the world falls in love".

**ELAINE** 

Of course, it is!!!!

BUDDY

No! In fact, Christmas is the time of year when the suicide rate nearly doubles and the homicide rate skyrockets...

**ELAINE** 

It does not! That's a horrible thing to...

**BUDDY** 

It does too! Every year at Christmastime...

**ELAINE** 

You are always so negative.

BUDDY

I'm not.

**ELAINE** 

And you are also incredibly inconsiderate!

**BUDDY** 

I am not! I'm very considerate!

Ha! You haven't even commented on my outfit.

**BUDDY** 

(After a beat)

No, I haven't.

**ELAINE** 

So...what do you think?

BUDDY

Is that what you're wearing?

**ELAINE** 

Yes!

**BUDDY** 

Really?

**ELAINE** 

YES!!!!

BUDDY

Okay.

(SHE sits at her vanity to touch up her makeup pretending HIS comment didn't bother her. Finally, she must ask him)

**ELAINE** 

Why, what's wrong with it?

(HE doesn't answer)

What is wrong with what I'm wearing?

(PAUSE as he contemplates his answer)

BUDDY

Nothing.

**ELAINE** 

Tell me God dammit!

BUDDY

No. Really. It's fine.

**ELAINE** 

No, it's obviously not fine.

BUDDY

It's fine!!!

**ELAINE** 

You wouldn't have made that snarky comment if it was fine.

**BUDDY** 

What snarky comment!?!

**ELAINE** 

(Imitating him)

Is that what you're wearing?

**BUDDY** 

I merely asked you if that's what you were wearing.

**ELAINE** 

As if to say...

**BUDDY** 

As if to nothing. It meant nothing.

**ELAINE** 

Yeah. Right.

**BUDDY** 

Stop reading into everything I say! Jesus!

ELAINE

Jesus? You're calling on him when you won't even let me sing one of his birthday songs?

BUDDY

Ah, sing what you want to sing.

**ELAINE** 

Just once I would like to walk in here and have you actually say something nice about the way I look!

**BUDDY** 

Oh, come on, that's not fair.

**ELAINE** 

How is that not fair?

**BUDDY** 

I always tell you...

**ELAINE** 

I can't remember the last time you gave me a compliment.

BUDDY I always do! **ELAINE** No, actually, you never do. BUDDY Rubbish! **ELAINE** Ugh! I'm surprised I have any positive self-esteem whatsoever! **BUDDY** Oh please. I always tell you when I think you look nice. **ELAINE** But not tonight. BUDDY I always tell you when I think you look nice. **ELAINE** So, I assume that means you don't approve of my ensemble tonight. BUDDY It's not my favorite. **ELAINE** Okay, well at least that's honest. BUDDY Yes. **ELAINE** Thank you for that! BUDDY You're welcome. **ELAINE** So, tell me! What is it that you don't like about this outfit?

BUDDY

It seems to be missing something.

**ELAINE** 

What?

BUDDY

A bottom.

What!?!

BUDDY

It looks like you forgot to put on the pants.

**ELAINE** 

This look happens to be very much en vogue right now and...and...

BUDDY

And...?

**ELAINE** 

And you are an idiot.

BUDDY

Yes. Of course, I am! So why do you ask me?

**ELAINE** 

I don't know. But don't worry...I won't ask you again.

**BUDDY** 

(HE goes back to his reading) Perfect.

(After a few moments of silence, HE rises and comes up from behind her and hugs her)

**ELAINE** 

Go away.

BUDDY

Aw, don't be mad my little secular snow bunny.

**ELAINE** 

How can I not be?

BUDDY

Aww...come on. You know how much I love you.

**ELAINE** 

Sometimes you got a funny way of showing it.

BUDDY

The real truth is I love you no matter what you wear. Why do you care what I think anyway? I don't know a thing about fashion...

**ELAINE** 

Well that's true...

**BUDDY** 

But I do know I love you and I know how lucky I am to have you in  $\ensuremath{\mathsf{my}}$  life.

Well okay then. It would be nice to hear it every now and again.

#### **BUDDY**

You are absolutely right! Tell you what...I'm going to make it my New Year's resolution to remind you every day of how much I love you.

#### **ELAINE**

Okay Sweetie, I didn't mean to start a row. I guess I'm just nervous about this party. Some of our friends can be so judgmental.

**BUDDY** 

I know Sweetie.

#### **ELAINE**

(Looking at her watch)

Well...tick tock, tick tock. I'm done in the bathroom. You'd better start getting ready.

BUDDY

What do you mean?

**ELAINE** 

We are supposed to be there at eight.

BUDDY

So?

## **ELAINE**

What part of that statement didn't you understand? It's getting late. It takes an hour to get there. When exactly did you plan to get dressed?

**BUDDY** 

I am dressed!

**ELAINE** 

Is that what you're wearing?

**BUDDY** 

Yes. Why? What's wrong it? What is wrong with what I'm wearing?

**ELAINE** 

Nothing. It's fine. Let's go.

(SHE turns off the light and they exit)

(BLACKOUT)
